### II. LIC e-Receipt Verification Process


LIC 's e-Receipts' Initiative enables it to send a Digitally Signed soft copy of the Premium Receipt to the Policy Holder through an email. The Policy Holder can verify the Digital Signature on the e-Receipt by a very simple method and can also print the same. Please note that it is not mandatory to verify the Digital Signature always. The Policy Holder can view and Print the e-Receipt successfully, even if he/she has not verified the same.

When the Policy Holder receives an e-Receipt from LIC, it is in PDF File Format and appears as follows:





Alternatively, the Policy Holders may receive an e-Receipt that looks like this (With a mark of 'Validity Unknown'):



This mark depicts that the Trusted Certificate Roots are not present on the viewers' computer and hence the Digital Signature cannot be validated.

The viewer needs to perform a one-time activity of explicitly adding the Trusted Roots on his/her computer. Once the Trusted Roots are added, the viewer can validate any Digitally Signed document.
