Only L-1, L-2, L-3 and other bidders who are in +10% range of L-3 bidder will be allowed to participate in the reverse auction for Mumbai and Pune data centres. 2. Reverse auction shall be carried only for Mumbai and Pune locations, simultaneously. 3. There shall be separate L-1 for both locations, i.e. Mumbai and Pune. The L-1 for Mumbai as well as Pune shall be arrived as outcome of the individual reverse auction processes. The same bidder can be L-1 at both locations.
