THE LIFE INSURANCE CORPORATION OF INDIA (hereinafter called "the Corporation") having received a Proposal and Declaration and the first premium from the Proposer and the Life Assured named in the Schedule referred to herein below and the said Proposal and Declaration with the statements contained and referred to therein having been agreed to by the said Proposer and the Corporation as basis of this assurance do by this Policy agree, in consideration of and subject to due receipt of the subsequent premiums as set out in the Schedule, to pay the Benefits but without interest at the Branch Office of the Corporation where this Policy is serviced to the person or persons to whom the same is payable in terms of the said Schedule, on proof to the satisfaction of the Corporation of the Benefits having become payable as set out in the Schedule, of the title of the said person or persons claiming payment and of the correctness of the age of the Life Assured stated in the Proposal if not previously admitted.

And it is hereby declared that this Policy of Assurance shall be subject to the Conditions and Privileges printed on the back hereof and that the following Schedule and every endorsement placed on the Policy by the Corporation shall be deemed part of the Policy.

CONDITIONS AND PRIVILEGES WITHIN REFERRED TO

1. Proof of Age:

The Mortality charge having been calculated based on the age of the Life Assured as declared in the Proposal, in case the age is found higher than such age, without prejudice to the Corporation's other rights and remedies, including those under the Insurance Act, 1938, the mortality charge shall be deductible in such case at the rate calculated on the respective Sum Assured for the correct age at entry, and the Corporation shall deduct by cancelling appropriate number of units out of Policyholder's Unit Account, the accumulated difference between these charges for the correct age and the charges as reckoned from the commencement of the Policy up to the date of such payment with interest at such rate as may be prevailing at the time of deduction.

Provided further that if the Life Assured's correct age at entry is such as would have made him/ her uninsurable under the class or terms of assurance specified in the said Schedule hereto, this policy shall be void and all claims to any benefit in virtue hereof shall cease and determine and all moneys that have been paid in consequence hereof shall belong to the Corporation, excepting as relief, as may be lawfully granted by the Corporation.

2. Policyholder's Unit Account:

The premiums paid by the Life Assured, after applying the allocation rate, as specified in this Policy document, shall be utilized to purchase units of the opted Investment fund at the Net Asset Value (NAV) on the date of purchase. The Units, so purchased, shall be credited to a personalized investment account, called the "Policyholder's Unit Account". The Policyholder's Unit Account shall be subject to deduction of charges, as specified in this Policy document. At any time during the Policy Term, the value of the Policyholder's Unit account shall be the number of units in the account multiplied by the NAV of the Units of that date. The NAV of units may increase or decrease depending upon the investment performance of the underlying fund.

3. Fund Unit Allocation and Investment of fund:

The allocated premiums will be utilized to buy units as per the fund type opted by the Life Assured (as shown in the Schedule) out of the following 4 Funds:

- a. <u>Bond Fund</u>: There will be no exposure to equity market in this fund. The indicative Portfolio allocation under this Fund will be as under:
 - (1) Investment in Government / Government Guaranteed securities / Corporate Debt: Not less than 80%
 - (2) Investment in Short-term such as Money Market instruments (Including (1) above): 100%
 - (3) Investment in Listed Equity Shares: Nil
- b. <u>Secured Fund</u>: The Fund will maintain a suitable balance between return, safety and liquidity. The indicative Portfolio allocation under this Fund will be as under:
 - (1) Investment in Government / Government Guaranteed securities / Corporate Debt: Not less than 65%
 - (2) Investment in Short-term such as Money Market instruments (Including (1) above): Not more than 85%
 - (3) Investment in Listed Equity Shares: Not less than 15% and not more than 35%
- c. Balanced Fund: The indicative Portfolio allocation under this Fund will be as under:
 - (1) Investment in Government / Government Guaranteed securities / Corporate Debt: Not less than 50%
 - (2) Investment in Short-term such as Money Market instruments (Including (1) above): Not more than 70%
 - (3) Investment in Listed Equity Shares: Not less than 30% and not more than 50%
- d. Growth Fund: The indicative Portfolio allocation under this Fund will be as under:
 - (1) Investment in Government / Government Guaranteed securities / Corporate Debt: Not less than 20%
 - (2) Investment in Short-term such as Money Market instruments (Including (1) above): Not more than 40%
 - (3) Investment in Listed Equity Shares: Not less than 60% and not more than 80%

The Life Assured will have to opt any ONE of the above 4 Funds. In case no Fund is opted the allocated premiums shall, by default be invested in the SECURED FUND.

4. Charges:

A) Premium Allocation Charge: This is the percentage of the premium appropriated towards charges from the premium received. The balance known as allocation rate constitutes that part of the premium which is utilized to purchase (Investment) units for the policy.

The allocation charges are as below:

For Single premium policies: 3.3%

For Regular premium policies:

- B) Other Charges: The Following charges shall be deducted by cancellation of appropriate number of units out of the Policyholder's Unit Account:
 - i) Mortality charge:

This is the cost of life insurance cover. Mortality charge, if any, will be taken every month by canceling appropriate number of units out of the Policyholder's Unit Account as per the rate prevalent at the time of policy.

If opted for Life cover, charge in respect of the same, during a policy year, will be based on the age nearer birthday of the Life Assured as at the Policy anniversary coinciding with or immediately preceding the due date of cancellation of units and hence shall increase every year on each policy anniversary. Further, the charge will also depend on the health, occupation and life style of the Life Assured.

The Life Cover charge per Rs. 1000/- Sum Assured, for standard lives is given as Annexure to this document.

ii) Accident Benefit charge: This is the charge to cover the cost of Accident Benefit rider (if opted for) levied every month by canceling appropriate number of units out of the Policyholder's Unit Account as per the rate prevalent at the time of policy issue.

A level charge, at present, is at the rate of Rs.0.50 per thousand Accident Benefit Sum Assured per policy year.

- Policy Administration charge: The Policy Administration charge of Rs. 60/- per month during the first policy year and Rs. 20/- per month thereafter, throughout the term of the policy, will be deducted by canceling appropriate number of units out of Policyholder's Unit Account.
- Service Tax Charge: A service tax charge shall be levied on charges for Life cover and Accident Benefit rider, if any, and shall be deducted by cancelling appropriate number of units out of the Policyholder's Unit Account on a monthly basis as and when the corresponding Life cover and Accident Benefit charges are deducted. The level of this charge will be as per the rate of Service Tax on risk premium, if any, as applicable from time to time.
- v) Miscellaneous Charge - This is a charge levied for an alteration within the contract, such as reduction in policy term, change in premium mode to higher frequency, Grant of Accident Benefit after the issue of the policy, etc. An alteration may be allowed subject to a charge of Rs. 50/- which will be levied by canceling appropriate number of units out of the Policyholder's Unit Account on the date of alteration in the policy.

The Corporation reserves the right to accept or decline the alteration in the policy. The alteration shall take effect from the policy anniversary coincident or following the alteration only after the same is approved by the Corporation and is specifically communicated in writing to the Life Assured.

- vi) Switching Charge: This is a charge levied on switching of monies from one fund to another and will be levied at the time of effecting switch. Within a given policy year, 4 switches shall be allowed free of charge. Subsequent switches shall be subject to a switching charge of Rs.100 per switch.
- C) Fund Management Charge: This is a charge levied as a percentage of the value of assets and shall be appropriated by adjusting NAV at the following rates:

0.75% p.a. of Unit Fund for "Bond" Fund 1.00% p.a. of Unit Fund for "Secured" Fund 1.25% p.a. of Unit Fund for "Balanced" Fund 1.50% p.a. of Unit Fund for "Growth" Fund

This is a charge levied at the time of computation of NAV, which will be done on daily basis.

D) Right to revise charges: The Corporation reserves the right to revise all or any of the above charges except Premium Allocation charge and charges for optional covers, as and when such a need will arise. The modification in charges will be done with prospective effect with the prior approval of Insurance Regulatory & Development Authority after giving the Life Assured a notice of 3 months.

Although the charges are reviewable, they will be subject to the following maximum limit:

- Policy Administration charge: This charge shall not exceed Rs. 150/- per month during the first policy year and Rs. 50/- per month thereafter, throughout the term of the policy.
- Fund Management Charge: The Maximum for each Fund will be as follows

i. Bond Fund: 1.5% p.a. of Unit Fund ii. Income Fund: 2.0% p.a. of Unit Fund

iii. Balanced Fund: 2.5% p.a. of Unit Fund

iv. Growth Fund: 3.0% p.a. of Unit Fund

 Miscellaneous Charge: The Miscellaneous Charge shall not exceed Rs. 100/- each time when an alteration is requested.

5. Method of Calculation of Unit Values:

The NAV will be computed on daily basis and will be based on investment performance, Fund Management Charge and whether fund is expanding or contracting under each fund type and shall be calculated as under:

Appropriation price (when fund is expanding):

Market value of investments held by the fund plus the expenses incurred in the purchase of the assets plus the value of any current assets plus any accrued income net of fund management charges less the value of any current liabilities less provisions, if any divided by the number of units existing at the valuation date (before any new units are allocated).

Expropriation price (when fund is contracting):

Market value of investments held by the fund less the expenses incurred in the sale of assets plus the value of any current assets plus any accrued income net of fund management charges less the value of any current liabilities less provisions, if any divided by the number of units existing at the valuation date (before any units redeemed).

6. Applicability of Net Asset Value (NAV):

The premiums received up to a particular time (presently 4.15 p.m. as per IRDA guidelines) by the servicing branch of the corporation along with a local cheque or a demand draft payable at par at the place where the premium is received, the closing NAV of the day on which premium is received shall be applicable. The premiums received after such time by the servicing branch of the corporation along with a local cheque or a demand draft payable at par at the place where the premium is received, the closing NAV of the next business day shall be applicable.

Similarly, in respect of the valid applications received for surrender, death claim, switches etc up to such time by the servicing branch of the Corporation closing NAV of that day shall be applicable. For the valid applications received in respect of surrender, death claim, switches etc after such time by the servicing branch of the Corporation the closing NAV of the next business day shall be applicable

In respect of amount available on vesting, NAV of the date of vesting of annuity shall be applicable.

7.Offer and Bid Price:

The Offer price is the price at which the Corporation is prepared to create/ allot Fund Unit/s in the opted Fund in respect of this policy. The Bid price is the price at which the Corporation is prepared to cancel (repurchase) Fund Unit/s in the Fund in respect of this policy. As there is no Bid-Offer spread, the Bid price and the Offer price under this plan are equal to the NAV.

8. Top-up (Additional Premium):

The Life Assured can pay additional premium in multiples of Rs.1,000 without any limit at anytime during the term of the policy. Any such Top-up, net of the charges specified in the schedule of the policy, shall be used to provide additional units and will not provide any additional risk cover under the policy. In case of Regular Premium policies (where premiums are payable yearly or more frequently), such Top-up can be paid only if all premiums due till that time have been paid under the policy.

9. Discontinuance of Premiums:

In case of Regular premium policies, if premium/s have not been duly paid within the days of grace under the Policy, the Policy will lapse. The life assured will have an option to revive the policy within the specified period (described in Condition 12 below).

- Where atleast 3 full years' premiums have been paid, the Life cover and Accident Benefit cover, if any, shall continue during the revival period.
 - During this period, the charges for Life Cover and Accident Benefit cover, if any, shall be taken as usual by cancelling an appropriate number of units out of the Policyholder's Unit Account every month. This will continue to provide relevant risk covers for:
 - i) two years from the due date of first unpaid premium, or
 - ii) the date of vesting, or
 - iii) till such period that the Policyholder's Unit Account reduces to one annualized premium, whichever is earlier.

The benefits payable under the policy in different contingencies during this period shall be as under:

- A. <u>In case of Death</u>: Life cover Sum Assured plus Fund Value of units held in the Policyholder's Unit Account, if life cover is opted for. If life cover is not opted for, then only Fund Value of units held in the Policyholder's Unit Account is payable.
- B. <u>In case of Death due to accident</u>: Accident Benefit Sum Assured in addition to the amount under A above, if Accident Benefit is opted for.
- C. <u>In case of Surrender</u>: Fund Value of units held in the Policyholder's Unit Account. Surrender value, however, shall be paid only after completion of 3 policy years.
- D. On vesting: Fund Value of units held in the Policyholder's Unit Account.
- E. Compulsory surrender: The policy shall be terminated compulsorily in following cases:
 - i)The balance in the Policyholder's Unit Account, at all times, shall be subject to a minimum balance of one annualized premium. In case the Policyholder's Unit Account falls below this limit, the policy shall compulsorily be terminated with a notice to the Life Assured and the balance amount in the Policyholder's Unit Account, if any, shall be refunded to the policyholder.
 - ii)In case the policy is not revived during the revival period, the policy will expire and the Life Cover and Accident Benefit cover, if any, shall cease and charges for these benefits and also other charges shall not be deducted thereafter. Fund value of units shall be refunded to the policyholder.
- ii. Where the policy lapses without payment of at least 3 years' premiums, the Life Cover and Accident Benefit cover, if any, shall cease and no charges for these benefits shall be deducted. However deduction of all the other charges shall continue. The benefits under such a lapsed policy shall be payable as under:
 - F. In case of Death: Fund Value of units held in the Policyholder's Unit Account.
 - G. In case of death due to accident: The amount under F above.
 - H. In case of Surrender: Fund Value of units / money value of units, as the case may be, held in the

Policyholder's Unit Account, shall be payable after the completion of the third policy anniversary.

I. Compulsory Surrender: In case the policy is not revived during the period of revival, then the policy shall be terminated after completion of three years from the date of commencement of the policy or on expiry of revival period, whichever is later. In case the period of revival expires before the end of third policy year, then the fund value of units, if any, shall be converted into monetary terms at the NAV of that day and no charges shall be deducted thereafter. This monetary amount shall be paid to the policyholder after the end of third policy year.

10. Surrender of Policies:

The surrender value, if any, is payable only after the completion of the third policy anniversary. The surrender value will be the Fund Value of units held in the Policyholder's Unit Account at the date of surrender. There will be no surrender charge.

If a Life Assured applies for surrender of the policy within 3 years from the date of commencement of policy, then the Fund Value of units shall be converted into monetary terms at the NAV of that day. No charges shall be made thereafter and this monetary amount shall be paid on completion of 3 years from the date of commencement of policy.

Irrespective of whether the policy is a Single Premium or Regular Premium policy or has run for less or more than three years, if the balance in the Policyholder's Unit Account, at any time is not sufficient to recover the relevant charges, the policy shall compulsorily be terminated and the balance amount in the Policyholder's Unit Account, if any, will be refunded to the policyholder.

Partial Surrender of units shall not be allowed.

11. Days of Grace:

A grace period of one calendar month but not less than 30 days will be allowed for payment of yearly or half-yearly or quarterly premiums. If the death of Life Assured occurs within the grace period but before the payment of premium then due, the policy will still be valid and the death benefits shall be paid after deduction of all relevant charges, if not recovered.

If the premium is not paid before the expiry of the days of grace, the policy lapses and benefits shall be paid as mentioned under Condition 9 above.

12. Revival of Discontinued policies:

If due premium is not paid within the days of grace, the policy lapses. A lapsed policy can be revived during the period of two years from the due date of first unpaid premium or before date of vesting, whichever is earlier. The period during which the policy can be revived will be called "revival period".

If premiums have not been paid for at least 3 years, the policy may be revived within two years from the due date of first unpaid premium. If the life cover is opted for, the revival shall be made on submission of proof of continued insurability to the satisfaction of the Corporation and the payment of all the arrears of premium without interest. The Corporation reserves the right to accept the revival at its own terms or decline the revival of a lapsed policy. The revival of a lapsed policy shall take effect only after the same is approved by the Corporation and is specifically communicated in writing to the Life Assured.

If life cover is not opted for, the revival shall be made on the payment of all the arrears of premium without interest.

If at least 3 years' premiums have been paid and subsequent premiums are not paid, the policy may be revived within two years from the due date of first unpaid premium but before the date of vesting, if earlier. No proof of continued insurability is required and all arrears of premium without interest can be paid, irrespective of whether life cover is opted for or not.

Irrespective of what is stated above, if less than 3 years' premiums have been paid and Fund Value of units held in Policyholder's Unit Account is not sufficient to recover the charges, the policy shall terminate and thereafter revival will not be allowed. If 3 years or more than 3 years premiums have been paid and Fund Value of units held in Policyholder's Unit Account reduces to one annualized premium, the policy shall terminate and Fund Value of units as on such date shall be refunded to the policyholder and thereafter revival will not be allowed.

Reinstatement of surrendered policy shall not be allowed.

13. Forfeiture in certain events:

In case the premiums shall not be duly paid or in case any condition herein contained or endorsed hereon shall be contravened or in case it is found that any untrue or incorrect statement is contained in the proposal, personal statement, declaration and connected documents or in case any material information is withheld, then and in every such case but subject to the provisions of Section 45 of the Insurance Act, 1938, wherever applicable, this policy shall be void and all claims to any benefit in virtue hereof shall cease and determine and all moneys that have been paid in consequence hereof shall belong to the Corporation, excepting always in so far as relief is provided in terms of the Privileges herein contained or as may be lawfully granted by the Corporation.

14.Suicide:

No risk claim will be paid in case the Life Assured commits suicide (whether sane or insane at the time) at any time on or after the date on which the risk under the policy has commenced but before the expiry of one year from the date of commencement of risk under this policy. The Corporation will not entertain any claim by virtue of this policy except to the extent of the Fund Value of the units held in the Policyholder's Unit Account on death, as a result of such suicide.

15.Loans:

No loan will be available under this policy.

16. Assignments and Nominations:

No assignment will be allowed under this policy.

Notice of Nomination should be submitted for registration to the Office of the Corporation, where this policy is serviced. In registering a nomination the Corporation does not accept any responsibility or express any opinion as to its validity or legal effect.

17. Accident Benefit Rider:

If Accident benefit is opted for, at any time when this cover is in force, the Corporation agrees to pay an additional sum equal to the Accident Benefit Sum Assured under this policy if

- the Life Assured is involved in an accident resulting in death or
- the Life Assured shall sustain any bodily injury resulting solely and directly from the accident caused by outward, violent and visible means and such injury shall within 180 days of its occurrence solely, directly and independently of all other causes result in the death of the Life Assured

and the same is proved to the satisfaction of the Corporation. However, such additional sum payable in respect of this policy shall not in any event exceed Rs.50,00,000 taking all existing policies of the Life Assured under individual as well as group policies including policies taken with Life Insurance Corporation of India and other insurance companies.

The Corporation shall not be liable to pay the additional sum referred above, if death of the Life Assured:

- be caused by intentional self-injury, attempted suicide, insanity or immorality or whilst the Life Assured is under the influence of intoxicating liquor, drug or narcotic; or
- ii) takes place as a result of an accident while the Life Assured is engaged in aviation or aeronautics in any capacity other than that of a fare-paying, part-paying or non-paying passenger in any aircraft which is authorized by the relevant regulations to carry such passengers and flying between established aerodromes, the Life Assured having at that time no duties on board the aircraft or requiring descent there from; or
- be caused by injuries resulting from riots, civil commotion, rebellion, war (whether war be declared or not), invasion, hunting, mountaineering, steeple-chasing or racing of any kind; or
- iv) results from the Life Assured committing any creach of law; or
- v) arises from employment of the Life Assured in the armed forces or military service of any country at war (whether war be declared or not) or from being engaged in police duty in any military, naval or police organization.
- vi) occurs after 180 days from the date of accident of the Life Assured.

This benefit will be available only till the date on which the annuity vests (as given in the Schedule) or till the policy anniversary on which the age nearer birthday of the Life Assured is 70 years, whichever is earlier. No charges for this benefit shall be deducted from the Policy anniversary at which the benefit ceases.

18. Increase / Decrease of benefits:

No increase (except to the extent of Top-up) or decrease in benefits will be allowed under the plan.

19. Option to switch between funds:

The policyholder can switch from one Fund to another out of the four funds mentioned in Condition 3 above, during the policy term, provided the application for a switch is received at the Office of the Corporation where the policy is serviced. In a given policy year, the Life Assured can make 4 switches free of charge. Subsequent switches in the policy year shall be subject to a switching charge of Rs.100 per switch.

On receipt of the Life Assured's application for a switch, subject to the above conditions, the Fund Value of the Units held in the Policyholder's Unit account after deduction of Switching charges, if any, shall be transferred to the New Fund opted by the Life Assured and shall be utilized to allocate Fund Units to the policy at the NAV under the New Fund of the said date of the switch. If a valid application is received up to a particular time, presently 4.15 p.m. as per IRDA guidelines, by the servicing branch the closing NAV of the same day shall be applicable and in respect of the applications received after such time by the servicing branch the closing NAV of the next business day shall be applicable.

Switching will not be allowed under a lapsed policy.

20. Risks borne by the Life Assured:

The Value of the units as well as the Benefits relating to the Policyholder's Unit Account are subject to market and other risks and there can be no assurance that the objectives of any of the above funds will be achieved. Further, the value of units within each Fund can go up or down depending on the different factors affecting the capital markets and may also be affected by changes in the general level of interest rates and other economic factors. All benefits under the policy are also subject to the Tax Laws and other Financial enactments as they become applicable from time to time.

21. Normal requirements for a claim

The normal documents which the claimant shall submit while lodging the claim in case of death of the Life Assured shall be the claim forms, as prescribed by the Corporation, accompanied with original policy document, proof of title, proof of death, proof of accident, medical treatment prior to death, employer's certificate, whichever is applicable, to the satisfaction of the Corporation. If the age is not admitted under the policy, the proof of age of the Life Assured shall also be submitted.

At the vesting date of the policy or in case of surrender, the Life Assured shall submit the discharge form along with the original policy document besides proof of age, if the age is not admitted earlier.

22. Legislative Changes

The Terms and Conditions including the premiums and benefits payable under this policy are subject to variation in accordance with the relevant Legislation & Regulations.

Section 45 of Insurance Act, 1938

"No policy of life insurance effected before the commencement of this act shall after the expiry of two years from the date of commencement of this Act and no policy of life insurance effected after the coming into force of this Act shall after the expiry of two years from the date on which it was effected, be called in question by an insurer on the ground that a statement made in the proposal for insurance or in any report of a medical officer, or referee, or friend of the insured, or in any other document leading to the issue of the policy, was inaccurate or false, unless the insurer shows that such statement was on a material matter or suppressed facts which it was material to disclose and it was fraudulently made by the Policyholder and that the Policyholder knew at the time of making it that the statement was false or that it suppressed facts which it was material to disclose:

Provided that nothing in this section shall prevent the insurer from calling for proof of age at any time if he is entitled to do so, and no policy shall be deemed to be called in question merely because the terms of the policy are adjusted on subsequent proof that the age of the life assured was incorrectly stated in the proposal."
