Engineering, Mfg Cos Driving Demand for Office Spaces

Bengaluru: Demand for Indian office space is undergoing a transformative shift as engineering, manufacturing and flexible office leasing have taken the lead, challenging the dominant IT/TES sector, as per a Colliers report.

Engineering and manufacturing firms witnessed a three-fold year-on-year rise in demand, as per the study, as occupiers continued to take up larger spaces across top markets. Bengaluru and Chennai were the most preferred locations for engineering and manufacturing companies for their office expansions.

"Engineering, manufacturing, BFSI and flex spaces have seen a strong rise in leasing, at 71% rise YoY in Q2 2023. This signals optimism and growth in domestic consumption and investment, translating into office space demand," said P. Ush Jain, managing director, office services, India, Colliers.

Some of the big technology firms that leased large office spaces include Shell, ABB, LTTTS and Helion. "There is a good demand for 1 lakh-2 lakh sq ft office space, and we expect more businesses to come to the country due to the global economic crisis. We are also looking to rebuild the commercial portfolio," said Irfan Razack, CMD at Prestige Group.

According to the report, despite a weak demand scenario, the technology sector's share of Indian office space decreased from 40% in Q2 2022 to 36% in Q2 2023, yet it retained its dominant position. Companies persist in incorporating flexible office spaces into their real estate portfolio, with a substantial 30% YoY rise during the quarter, as occupiers embrace flex space as a long-term strategy.

"Flex spaces continue to gain larger ground as occupiers focus on building operational efficiencies through a hybrid and distributed work model," said Jain.

Govt Calls Meet to Promote Toy Exports

New Delhi: The government and toy industry will on Saturday discuss ways to promote toy exports from the country amid talks of the government considering production-linked incentive (PLI) scheme for the sector.

Officials said that Funskool, Lego and Hamleys, are among the 20 Indian and foreign companies who are expected to participate in the talks which will be chaired by industry secretary Rajesh Kumar Singh.

Trai explores if emergency ban on WA & FB messages feasible

Starts Talks, Will Send Suggestions To Govt For Action

New Delhi: Mindful of the heightened popularity of voice/video and messaging communication through OTT service providers like WhatsApp, Telegram, Facebook and Facetime in India, telecom regulator Trai has started discussions on whether specific apps and websites should be banned in the country under the provisions of Telecom Services (Public Emergency or Public Safety) Rules, 2017 or any other law during emergency situations. Trai, which has come out with a Consultation Paper on Regulatory Mechanism for OTT Communication Services, is seeking answers to what could be the technical challenges in select-

ing dynamic IP addresses and are hosted on cloud servers can pose a challenge to conventional methods of blocking. In such situations, alternative methods may be necessary to effectively control internet filtering. Advanced techniques can be employed to identify and block access to such websites," Trai's papers said.

It also asked what classes of OTT services should be covered under selective banning. "What should be the provisions and mechanism for such a regulatory framework... Whether there is a need to selectively ban specific websites apart from OTT services to meet the purposes," it asked in its discussion paper that will help finalise recommendations which would be submitted to the department of telecom (DoT) for further action.

Trai also wants to know whether there is a need to bring OTT communication services under any licensing/regulatory framework to

promote a competitive landscape for the benefit of consumers and service innovation. Also, the regulator wants to know what should be the provisions in the licensing/regulatory framework for OTT communication services that should be focused upon specifically. These may include areas like lawful interception; privacy and security; emergency services; unsolicited commercial communication; customer verification; quality of service; consumer grievance redressal; and license fee.

Telecom companies such as Airtel and Vodafone Idea have long argued for a "same services same rules" regulatory environment where all those providing voice/video and messaging services should be brought under the same set of regulatory mandates. "Written comments on the issues raised in the consultation paper are invited from stakeholders by August 4 and counter comments by August 18," Trai said.

Sambhajinagar farmer killed in road rage; 2 held

Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar: A 35-year-old farmer died on Friday morning after being stabbed by five men in an incident of road rage two days ago, reports **Mohammed Akhef**. Five of his friends escaped with injuries and are undergoing treatment.

The farmer has been identified as Ramchandra Hivale. Police have arrested two people and are looking for three others. Aurangabad SP Manoj Kalwaniya said the police have taken cognizance of the murder and would take appropriate action. On Wednesday night, seven to eight men were returning home in a jeep after celebrating a birthday in dhaha. A car tailing them abruptly overtook their vehicle, forcing the jeep driver to screech to a halt. When the occupants of the jeep questioned the car driver, the latter reportedly turned aggressive. But both parties soon called a truce. Within minutes, the car started chasing the jeep and waylaid it. The men in the car fished out sharp-edged weapons and metal rods, and started attacking the occupants of the jeep, the police said.

Wary of reel hunters, Kedar mulls ban on mobile phones

Dehradun: Exasperated at YouTubers and social media influencers shooting videos and reels in Kedarnath premises, the Badrinath Kedarnath Temple Committee (BKTC), which manages the administration of Kedarnath and Badrinath shrines, has now written to senior police officers to "take strict action against such persons," adding that they are planning to "set up a cloak room, where the mobile handsets of devotees can be deposited in order to curb these practices in future."

The development comes after a video of a YouTuber purportedly proposing to her boyfriend inside the temple premises started circulating on social media. Terming this as "a trend that is hurting the shrine's religious sanctity", the BKTC letter written by its executive officer, Ramesh Chandra Tiwari, said, "It has come to our notice that some social media influencers are shooting videos at

Kedarnath which are religiously objectionable and have hurt the feelings of devotees. Strict action should be taken in this regard so that such acts are not repeated in a place of worship." BKTC chief Ajendra Ajay, meanwhile, told TOI that while a cloak room to deposit devotees' mobile phones is being mullied, there are logistical challenges in it as pilgrim turnout at the shrine is often very high and it would be a big task to effectively manage the phone collection. Law panel: Not linked to UCC WA messages doing rounds

New Delhi: The Law Commission on Friday issued a disclaimer to inform the public regarding certain WhatsApp messages and calls being circulated pertaining to the Uniform Civil Code (UCC).

"It has come to notice that certain phone numbers are rotating among individuals, falsely associating them with the Law Commission. It is clarified that the commission has no involvement or connection with these texts, calls or messages, and disclaims any responsibility or endorsement thereof," it said. The Law Commission only communicates through official channels, including its website lawcommissionofindia.nic.in and official publication through the Press Information Bureau, the panel said.

"Individuals are encouraged to visit the official website of the Law Commission to access the public notice issued in this regard," it said, adding that it is stated in the public notice, dated June 14, that "suggestions, views or inputs regarding the Uniform Civil Code may be presented through 'click here' button or by email at membersecretary-1@govin to the Law Commission of India".

Muslim leaders urge community to oppose UCC

New Delhi: Some prominent Muslims religious leaders issued a public appeal to all members of the community to respond to the Law Commission, registering their opposition to UCC, reports **Ambika Pandit**. In a public notice on June 14, the law panel had asked for views on UCC from the stakeholders and public, including religious organisations, within 30 days.

In a joint statement, the clerics reiterated their opposition to any proposal to bring UCC and asserted that there is a consensus among the 'Ummah' (community of believers) regarding the authority of Muslim personal law which flows from the Quran.

Patna: The Nitish Kumar government has finally begun efforts to provide monetary compensation of Rs4 lakh each to the next of kin of the 53 people who died after consuming spurious liquor in Nalanda and East Champaran districts of Bihar this year.

An official information provided by the state police headquarters on Friday said the government would pay a total of Rs2.12 crore as compensation to the family members of the 53 spurious liquor death victims. "The report for paying compensation to the victim families has already been prepared and the money will be disbursed soon," a statement issued by the police headquarters said.

According to the press statement, at least four cases were registered with the Turkaulia, Paharpur, Harisidhi and Sugauli police stations in East Champaran

district on April 14-15 this year after 41 people died there under mysterious circumstances and their post-mortem reports confirmed death after consuming spurious liquor.

Similarly, 12 people died in Sohsrai police station area in Nalanda district on January 15 last year and their post-mortem reports also confirmed death due to consumption of toxic liquor. "Nalanda had one of the oldest liquor death cases and, hence, it was chosen first for paying compensation. The

affected families in other districts too will get compensation one by one. When it has been decided to pay compensation to all, everyone will get it by turn," JDU national general secretary Rajib Ranjan explained.

In December last year, Saran district hit the headlines for reporting a large number of deaths from spurious liquor. A report by the National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) said 77 people had died in hooch tragedy there. Besides highlighting the "inefficiency" of the local administration and excise department, the NHRC, in its 18-page report, also stated how the local administration had cremated many bodies without conducting post-mortem.

The CM had earlier rejected the BJP and Left parties' demand for compensation to the bereaved families, saying: "Jo pylega, so marega (those who drink liquor will die)". Nitish had imposed total prohibition in the state in April, 2016.

Sr TN IPS officer asks security officer for gun, shoots himself

Coimbatore: A senior IPS officer in Tamil Nadu, C Vijayakumar (47), shot himself with his personal security officer's pistol at his residence in Coimbatore on Friday morning. Senior officers said he was under medication for depression.

Police said Vijayakumar, who was deputy inspector general (DIG) of police (Coimbatore range), came out of his residence at Red Fields near Race Course Road around 6.45am to play badminton at the nearby Police Recruits School. He asked his PSO Ravichandran, who was at the camp office adjoining the DIG's residence, to hand over his service pistol. Around 6.50am, he put

the gun to his right temple and pulled the trigger even as the PSO stood a few feet away, police said.

The PSO raised an alarm and the gunshot drew policemen posted on the campus to the scene. They found Vijayakumar in a pool of blood and rushed him to the Coimbatore Medical College Hospital (CMCH). Doctors declared him dead on arrival. The bullet had come out of the left side of the head.

Preliminary inquiries revealed that Vijayakumar contacted R Sudhakar, inspector general of police (IGP), West Zone, Coimbatore, over phone on Thursday and told him that he was having suicidal thoughts. Immediately, Sudhakar invited Vijayakumar and his wife Geethavani over to his ho-

use and spoke with them for more than two hours. Later, Coimbatore superintendent of police V Bodhinarayana also visited Vijayakumar at his residence and spoke to him for an hour.

Vijayakumar and his wife had also attended the first birthday celebrations of the son of a deputy commissioner of police on Thursday night.

Quoting a doctor who had treated the 2008 batch IPS officer, additional director general of police (ADGP)-law & order A Arun said Vijayakumar was suffering from obsessive-compulsive disorder-cum-depression. "Depression was the reason for Vijayakumar's suicide," he added.

After post-mortem, Vijayakumar's body was sent to his hometown Anakkarakatti in Theni district.
